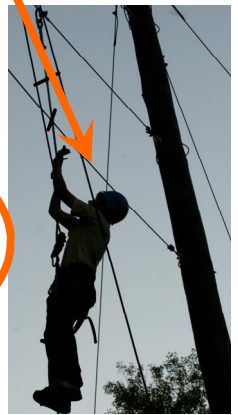
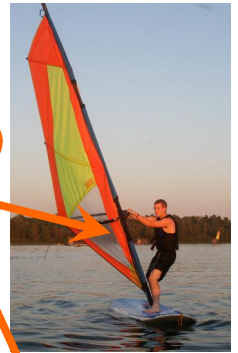

Kodiak Training at Many Point

Youth ages 16 - 21

Kodiak is an advanced leadership training open to any youth age 16 - 21. Because this course has very little 'class time' most of the skills are learned while being part of an active trek. While on the trek, participants will have the opportunity to be part of unique outdoor experiences like aquatics, biking, shooting, C.O.P.E. and climbing.
