How does it work at Many Point?

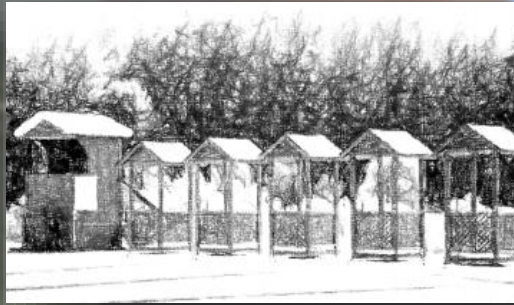
- Safety is our top priority, and we have dedicated, trained shooting sports staff at all times.

About Five Stand at Many Point



- Five Stand gets its name because Scouts rotate between 5 different stands or stations. Each station has a unique set of clays coming from different directions, that provide unique challenges for each Scout.
- Scouts will shoot six times at each station. At each station they shoot at two different targets, three times each.
- The first two shots will be single shots at each target. The next four shots will be "Report Pairs," where the first target is launched, and immediately after it is shot at, the second target is launched.
- After each Scout has finished at their station, they will rotate to a new station and experience a new challenge.
